SAFMR Payment Standard Look-up Tables

Payment standards are used to calculate the maximum subsidy that the PHA will pay toward rent and utilities for families with Housing Choice Vouchers. Effective **January 1, 2021**, Clearwater Housing Authority will use different payment standards in each of five (5) areas. Owners and tenants can identify the applicable payment standard area using the ZIP code where the unit is located.

To determine the applicable payment standard amount for a rental unit:

Step 1. Look for the ZIP code to identify the payment standard area (A through E)
