- You are a Pinellas County resident/family 18 years of age or older
- You have a COVID-related qualifying event (loss of income/job, laid off, or company closed due to COVID-19)
- Your income is at/below the 200% Federal Poverty Level at the time of your application
- You have less than \$4,000 savings in the bank
- Willing to submit verifiable documentation

Ways to Avoid Coronavirus Scams

- Don't respond to texts, emails or calls about checks from the government.
- lanore online offers for vaccinations. There are no products proven to treat or prevent COVID-19 at this time.
- Be wary of ads for test kits. Most test kits being advertised have not been approved by the FDA and aren't necessarily accurate.
- Hang up on robocalls. Scammers are using illegal robocalls to pitch everything from low-priced health insurance to work-at-home schemes.
- Watch for emails claiming to be from the CDC or WHO. Don't click on links from sources you don't know. Use sites like coronavirus.gov and usa.gov/coronavirus to get the latest information.
- Do your homework when it comes to donations. Never donate in cash, by gift card, or wiring money.
